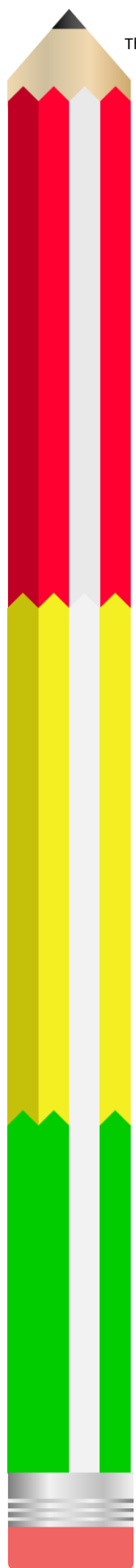


Our Remote Learning Plan



The plan complies with the expectations and principles outlined in the DFE Guidance for the Full Opening of Schools and the Coronavirus Act 2020 Provision of Remote Education (England) Temporary Continuity Direction.



Engage and Support

This plan will be applied in the following instances:

- ***An individual is self-isolating because of a positive test within the household;***
- ***A group of children are self-isolating because of a case of coronavirus in the bubble;***
- ***A whole bubble or cohort is self-isolating because of an outbreak of coronavirus***
- Our schools will continue supporting their community and provide regular updates and information via their school websites.
- To support our children who are entitled to FSM who are shielding with Covid -19 symptoms, our schools will have food available through our catering provider after discussion with the Headteacher.

Learning

- Our schools will follow the latest DFE guidance regarding remote education during corona virus and the safeguarding and remote education guidance.
- Our schools will set appropriate work in-line with their current curriculum and use a range of DFE recommended remote education resources to support pupils with their learning such as Teams, Oak National Academy White Rose Maths, BBC Bitesize.
- Our schools will have a blended approach to learning; with work shared for those unable to attend set weekly and in the event of a bubble closure - face to face contact with their teacher at least once a day
- Our schools will utilise their own systems for praise and sharing good practices such as Class Dojo, Virtual Assemblies etc.
- Where children would normally receive additional support from SEND agencies, the SENDCO will arrange for those to continue via other means as long as the agencies engage.

Contact

- Our Parents must communicate Covid-19 symptoms and test results to their school to ensure that they can inform the DFE /PHE with confirmed infection data.
- In the event of a bubble closure, this will be communicated as soon as possible through official channels and only with consensus from the Trust by following DFE / PHE guidance.
- If any child is vulnerable in any way, our schools will ensure that appropriate agencies are notified and arrange for regular safe and well checks via a phone calls from a member of the school team.
- If our children are not engaging with home learning will receive a phone call from a member of the school team to discuss the obstacles and support.
